

## Grants collected through the Office of Environmental Sustainability/Office of Community Sustainability

### **ENERGY**

\$2.6 Million - Energy Efficiency Block Grant, US DOE. Used for a variety of programs including the installation of energy efficient lighting on cedar lane ball fields, creation of an energy management program for the county and free residential energy audits.

\$200,000 – Retrofit reimbursements, BGE. Used for the retrofitting of existing lighting within county owned facilities.

\$36,500 –MEA. Used with the Housing Commission to replace inefficient HVAC and appliances at the Morningside community.

\$45,000 –MEA. Used with the Housing Commission to replace inefficient HVAC and appliances at the Orchard Crossing community.

### **TREES**

\$821,100 – MD DNR. Used to plant trees along with middle and high school students.

### **FOOD**

\$100,000 –Horizon Foundation. Supported the development of a comprehensive food policy strategy as well as the implementation of the Roving Radish

\$50,000 – United Way. Supported the distribution of Roving Radish meal kits to families in need.

\$40,000 – Horizon Foundation. Supported the Roving Radish program.

### **STORMWATER**

\$16,200 – Chesapeake Bay Trust. Design of stormwater management “bump-outs” for installation on Patapsco River Road.

\$60,000 – MD DNR. Support for the READY program

\$1 Million – MD DNR. Support for the County’s partnership program with non-profits which zeroes out the non-profits stormwater utility fee in return for access to their land to develop stormwater best management practices.

\$20,090 - National Fish and Wildlife Foundation. Supported residential rain garden installations through Howard County’s CleanScapes program.

\$70,000 – Chesapeake Bay Trust – Support for the READY program.

\$612,000 MD DNR – Chesapeake and Atlantic Coastal Bays Trust Fund to install 2 non-point source pollution reduction projects (Trinity School bioretention and Patapsco River Road bioretention curb bump outs).

\$59,000 MD DNR – Support from the Emerging Issues program to assess CMAC retrofits for flood control and water quality in Howard County (awarded May 2018)

\$1,825,000 MD DNR – Chesapeake and Atlantic Coastal Bays Trust Fund to support the Cattail Creek Stream Restoration at Maple Dell Farm (awarded June 2018)
